

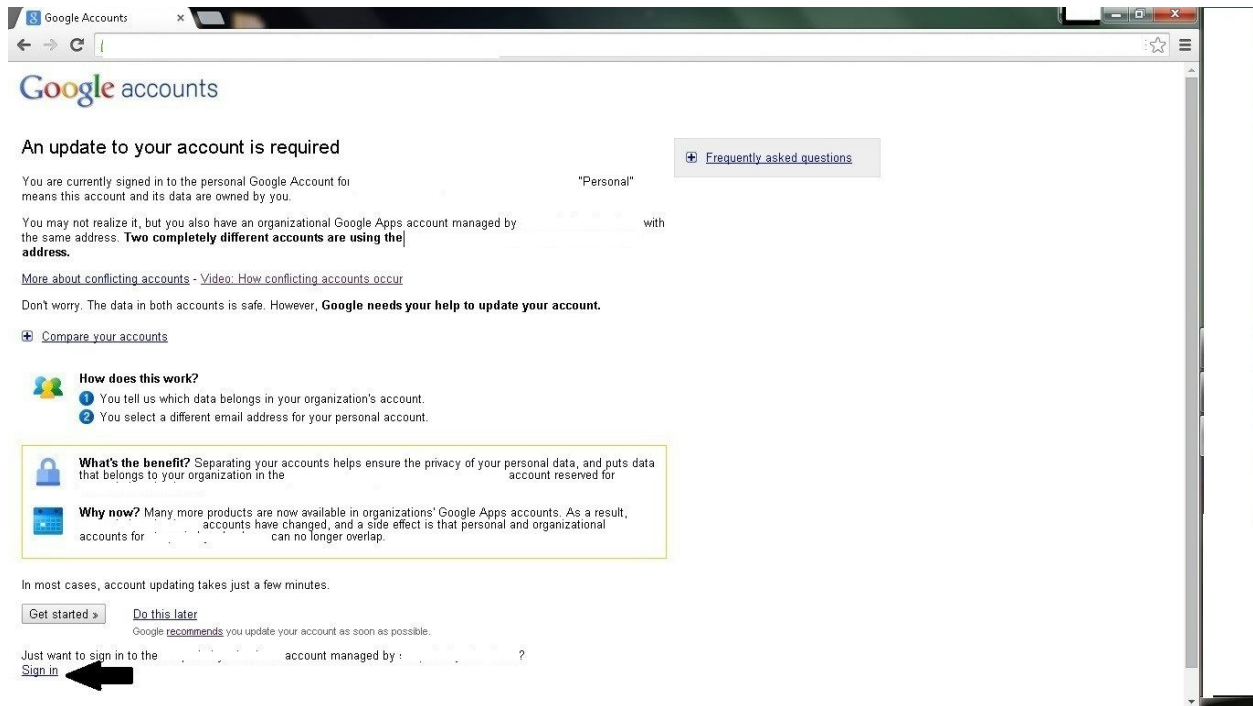
## Google Conflicting Account Directions

When the Paris Independent school district became part of the “Google Apps for Education” Network (GAPE.) Anyone who already had an existing Google account using their school email address was given a free temporary account so that none of their data would be lost.

If you previously associated a Google account with your school email address you may receive a message telling you that you are using a temporary account, your address is no longer available, or that you have a conflicting account.

Should you receive any of these messages please go to a normal computer workstation at school, home, the public library or etc. and visit [www.google.com](http://www.google.com).

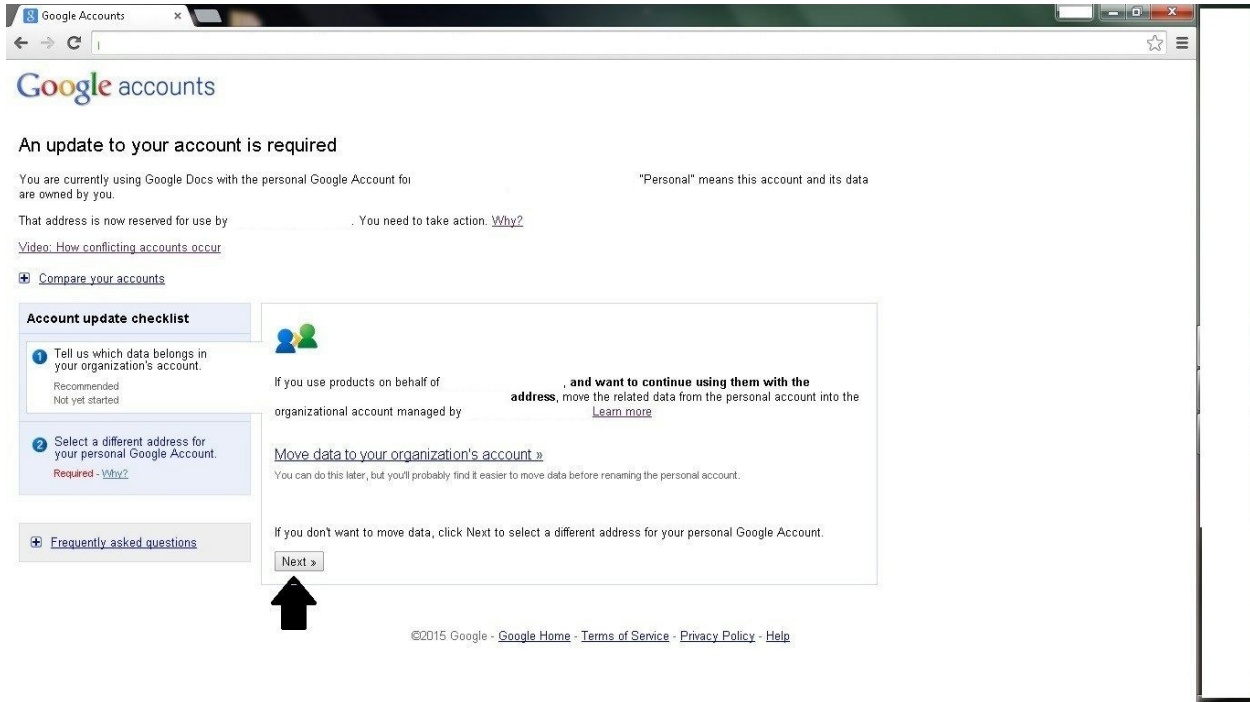
Sign in from the top right with your school email address.  
This will bring up the following screen.



Choosing **Sign-in** where the black arrow points will give you immediate access to your new account.

However, a permanent solution will require you to either merge your accounts or associate your old Google account with a personal email account.

When you click **Get started>** the following options will appear.



**Move data to your organization's account** only occasionally works.

The better choice is to click **Next** and follow the on-screen instructions to associate your old Google account with another e-mail address.

After you have associated your old Google account with an e-mail address other than your school email address, this error will no longer occur.
