

VERY IMPORTANT: New Immunization Certificates needed for most students in Fall 2018!

New immunization requirements effective July 1, 2018.

All students in kindergarten through 12th grade must show proof of having received two doses of Hepatitis A Vaccine to attend school.

If your child has not received his/her first dose of Hepatitis A, he/she will need to receive the first dose then wait 6 months before receiving the second dose.

In addition, students age 16 years or older, must show proof of having received two doses of Meningococcal ACWY vaccine to attend school. If the first dose of MenaCWY was received at age sixteen (16) years or older, the second dose is not required for school entry.

All students will need to present a current immunization showing proof of having received two doses of Hepatitis A Vaccine in order to attend school in Fall 2018. For students age 16 years and older, proof of Meningococcal ACWY is also required in order to attend school in the Fall.
