



HOMELESS CHILDREN AND YOUTH

The District shall provide educational and related services to homeless children and youth in a manner that does not segregate or stigmatize the students on the basis of their homeless status.

Have equal access to all educational programs and services, including transportation, that non-homeless children enjoy;

Continue attending their school of origin for the duration of homelessness;

Attend regular public school with non-homeless students; and

Continue to receive all services for which they are eligible (i.e., special education, gifted and talented, limited English proficient).
